**Rules and Regulations** 

Park Hours - Sunrise to 9:00 pm

Park in Designated Areas Only

## **The Following Actions Are Prohibited:**

- Inflatable Devices (Moon Bounce, Slides, Pools, etc.) are not to be used in the Park
- Setting Up of Tents, Tables or Other Structures
- Use of Tape, Tacks, Nails, Glue, etc., on any picnic table, gazebo, cabin, tree or on any other park amenity
- Possession or Consumption of any alcoholic béverages
- Cooking, Grilling or Open Fires of any kind
- Dumping or Discarding of any Trash, Refuse, or Other Litter.
- Swimming or Bathing in the River
- Use of Model Airplane, Drones, Motorcycles, Motor Scooters, Or Other Motorized Vehicles
- Hitting or Driving of Golf Balls
- Peddling and/or Soliciting (except by Permit)
- Bicycles, Skateboards, Roller Blades, etc.
- Unleashed Pets (Pet Waste MUST Be Picked Up)
- Defacing Restrooms, Gazebo's, Equipment, Trees, or any other amenity of the Park
- Threatening/ Abusive or Indecent Language, Fighting, or Other Disorderly Conduct
- PERMITS ARE REQUIRED FOR GROUPS OF TEN (10) PERSONS OR MORE FOR PICNICS, PARTIES, or other GATHERINGS

## Splash Pad Rules and Regulations

- 1. Use the splash pad at your own risk. There is NO lifeguard on duty.
- 2. Parents and guardians you are responsible for the safety and behavior of your children.
- 3. Appropriate footwear should be worn water shoes, sneakers etc.
- 4. No food or drink allowed in splash pad.
- 5. No bikes, skateboards, scooters or any other equipment with wheels
- 6. Wheelchairs are allowed for persons who require them.
- 7. Do not throw anything into the dump buckets.
- 8. Do not hang on any of the equipment.
- 9. Children who wear diapers must wear appropriate "swim diapers".
- 10. Children under the age of 10 must be accompanied by an adult.
- 11. No pushing shoving or other rough play.

The splash pad is here for everyone's enjoyment and is a very expensive piece of equipment. If you abuse it, you will lose it.
